1	Photos of Stall to be submitted with application (emailed Pics are acceptable).	
2	In keeping with a Medieval Theme the committee reserves the right to refuse any stall we deem inappropriate to this theme or change stall locations without notice.	
3	Stall Holders and any who tend their stalls must dress in appropriate Medieval Costume (these can be hired from the Carnivale).	
4	Stall Holders are prohibited to smoke or drink alcohol on site whilst trading.	
5	Only Two Day bookings will be considered.	
6	Only Two Event passes per application accepted will be issued.	
7	Stalls are 3 metres x 3 metres or 4 x 3 metres.	
8	Stall Holders can have access to site for set up on Friday 10am ~ 5pm & Saturday 6am ~ 8am.	
9	Stall Holders are to remove any supporting vehicles from the site prior to 8am Saturday .	
10	Stall Holders must be prepared for trade when site is opened to the public 10 am Saturday & Sunday and are expected to have enough supplies to operate through this period.	
11	Stall Holders are NOT permitted to exit venue prior to 4.30pm on Sunday to ensure the safety of visitors to the site. Enquiries Refer to Committee.	
12	Stall Holders who have indicated that they require a powered site shall provide their own electrical leads. The Balingup Medieval Carnivale reserves the right to refuse connection to power if safety standards are not adequate.	
13	All food stallholders must trade in accordance with ANZFA Food Standards Code and regulations and the Shire of Donnybrook Balingup Activities on Thoroughfares and Trading in Public Places local laws.	
14	Approved Stallholders will be issued with a permit from the Shire of Donnybrook Balingup. All permit conditions must be complied with. Stall Holders are not authorised to operate without a permit.	
15	Security of your stall is your responsibility however the Balingup Medieval Carnivale has a security guard after hours.	
16	Stall fees will not be refunded should inclement weather or factors beyond the control of the Balingup Medieval Carnivale committee affect the event.	
17	No refunds will be given for cancellations made within one month prior to the Carnivale
