



# **BALINGUP MEDIEVAL CARNIVALE**

## **2026 ENTERTAINER TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

### **1. All Entertainers are required to**

- Follow the direction of the Balingup Medieval Carnivale Committee and relevant representatives.
- Arrange and book their own Accommodation and supply their own Meals & Drinks.
- Dress in appropriate medieval themed Costume.
- Make displays look Medieval themed in appearance.
- Make every attempt to adhere to the schedule.
- Are prohibited from smoking or drinking alcohol on the Carnivale site.
- Be contracted by the Committee between the hours of 6pm Friday (all day Saturday) until Sunday 3pm.
- Be aware that images taken of Performers by those authorised by the Committee can and will be used in advertising, website & press releases.
- Comply with Shire of Donnybrook Balingup Activities on Thoroughfares and Trading in Public Places local laws.
- Advise the Event Manager of any unforeseen changes as soon as possible.
- Advise all performers in the groups of the terms and conditions of the application.
- Approved applicants will provide
  - an Invoice for payment (inclusive of GST and all banking details prior to the event
  - the legal names of all Entertainers and Support Crew
  - a copy of their public Liability Certificate

### **2. Access to Site for Entertainers, Support Crew and Vehicles**

- Entertainers will be required to provide identification and wear a coloured wristband.
- To ensure the safety of ticket holders, access to the event site with vehicles will be
  - Friday 3pm to 7pm
  - Saturday 6am to 9am
  - Sunday 6am to 9am and after 3.30pm
- The registration number of any required support vehicles entering the site is to be provided on the application form. Any vehicle registration changes must be submitted by email no later than 7 days prior to the event.
- All vehicles are required to follow the direction of our Gate and Traffic Movement staff.
- Parking for support vehicles is not available on the event grounds. Details of designated parking areas will be provided prior to the event.
- NO vehicles are to move around the site, enter or exit during the event. This includes Birdwood Park Road located adjacent to the Carnivale grounds. We suggest having alternative methods such as trolleys to cart equipment.
- The Balingup Medieval Carnivale Committee reserves the right to tow-away and forward costs to anyone who parks in the No Parking Zones or Disability Parking Areas without a permit.

### **3. Electrical**

- All electrical equipment must be listed on the application.
- All electrical equipment needs to have a current electrical testing tag.
- Entertainers who require power shall provide their own extension leads.
- The Balingup Medieval Carnivale Committee reserves the right to refuse connection to power if safety standards are not adequate.
- Please advise on your application (prior to event) if there is equipment you cannot supply and require assistance from BMC to provide.
- All changes must be notified prior to the event.

#### **4. Security**

- The security of equipment or display is the owner's responsibility.
- An overnight security guard is onsite both Friday and Saturday, although the Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage.

#### **5. Payment**

- Performance fees will be paid via direct deposit after the end of the event.
- Entertainers MUST provide an invoice (inclusive of ABN and all banking details) for payment prior to the event.
- Any payments will be made out to the Name on the invoice provided.
- Entertainers will still receive payment should inclement weather or factors beyond the control of the Committee affect the event.

#### **6. The Balingup Medieval Carnivale Committee reserves the right to**

- Make changes without notice to the Entertainment Program.
- Change the location and space available for Static Displays.
- Limit the amount of entry passes for large groups as we deem suitable.
- Refuse to connect to power if safety standards are not adequate.
- Deny applications without disclosure. The Committee's decision is final and is not under any obligation to provide performance feedback.
